RESOLUTION 2025-11-1

RESOLUTION FIXING FEES AND RATES

WHEREAS, the Kremmling Sanitation District (the “District”) is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado, located in the County of Grand, Colorado, and is a duly organized and existing special district pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-101 *et seq.*

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of the District is, pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-1001(1)(j)(i), empowered to fix and from time to time to increase or decrease fees, rates, tolls, penalties, or charges for services or facilities furnished by District.

WHEREAS, the District, pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-1006(1)(g), is empowered to fix and from time to time to increase or decrease tap fees.

WHEREAS, the District provided notice of its intent to hold a public hearing to fix fee, rates, tolls, penalties and charges on September 21, 2025 to the residents and property owners of the District, pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-1001(2)(a)(iii) and (iv), by positing such notice on the District’s official website and the website of the statewide association of special districts.

WHEREAS, the District conducted a public hearing, after giving more than thirty (30) days written notice of the public hearing to the residents and property owners of the District, pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-1001(2)(a), on November 10, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Kremmling Sanitation District as follows:

1. Fee Schedule. The fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated by this reference, is fixed as the fees, rates, tolls, penalties and charges imposed by the District.
2. Inconstant Fees or Rates. Any fee, rate, toll, penalty or other charge inconsistent with Exhibit A is repealed and made null and void.
3. Severability. If any part or provision of this Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board's intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.
4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately and remain in full force and effect until repealed or superseded by subsequent official action of the Board.

Fee Schedule

Effective: December 16, 2025

The Kremmling Sanitation District is empowered, from time to time to fix rates, fees, and tolls for the provision of sanitary sewer and wastewater collection and treatment system.

Fees are fixed based on the classification of the particular property and are calculated based on the single equivalent unit based on the proportional cost of service delivery.

Monthly Service Fees

- Single Equivalent Unit \$70.00
- Multi-User and Commercial \$70.00
- Commercial Overage (over 6,000 gallons) \$20.28 (per 1,000 gallons)
- Inactive Unit \$35.00

Tap Fee

A tap fee is a one-time charge paid by a property owner to connect a new building to the sewer system. The tap fee is calculated based on the single equivalent unit classification. Tap fees must be paid prior to the issuance of a building permit.

- Tap Fee \$10,000

Administrative Fees

- Late Fee (for bills paid more than 30 days after due) \$25.00
- Inspection Fee (for each inspection) \$250.00
- Inactive Administrative Fee (to initiate an inactive tap) \$20.00
